TRAINING



We carry out specialized and informative training on energy from a technical, consumer and health perspective addressed to professionals, people in vulnerable situations and citizens in general.

ENERGY INTERVENTIONS

Attention to people in vulnerable situations is basic for them to be empowered in energy use. We carry out audits adapted to the municipal Reality:

- · 1 or more home visits.
- Option to monitor energy and comfort (temperature and humidity measurements).

SUPPORT TO THE LOCAL WORLD

We provide technical support, consultancy, advice and coordination of municipal services in the field of energy in general and energy rights in particular.



Knowing the impact of the initiatives is essential. We evaluate the technical and social impact of projects and services once they have been completed in order to assess their replicability in the territory and to offer guarantees on whether the actions carried out are effective in combating energy poverty.

COMMUNICATION



We take care of all phases of the communication process of projects and services.



We plan and run campaigns, create content and multiplatform material.




We address beneficiaries and other public entities interested in replicating the actions.

National Strategy against Energy Poverty 2019-2024.

This policy instrument offers -for the first time-:

- an official definition of energy poverty;
- it establishes indicators for its monitoring and targets for its reduction (a minimum reduction target of 25% by 2025 and a goal of reaching a 50% reduction).
- Measures: social energy bonus for vulnerable consumers (automatic and all sources), household renovation and replacement of old appliances and equipment by efficient appliances.

ESTRATEGIA NACIONAL CONTRA LA POBREZA ENERGÉTICA 2019-2024






Existing national coping strategies

- Social bonus for domestic consumers-only for electricity
 - Higher discounts after COVID
- Ban from disconnection- from COVID
- Corrective measures- payment of energy bills



NEW! National coping strategies - 2023








- It extends the suspension of the 7% tax on electricity generation, in addition to other tax reductions on electricity and gas.
- The maximum selling price of butane is limited



Other initiatives to make vulnerable consumers access to just energy transition to overcome barriers such as:

- Lack of access to information (complex procedures, language, asimetric info,...)
- Financial barrier (can't access to credit, don't have cash,...)
- Limit to access grants for RES (tax penalty if 2 income-payers)
- Ownership patterns (owners tenants)
- Housing conditions (limitations for RES installation)
- Difficulties to participate governance structures














